Process

Skill Evaluations - All players will take part in the Skill Evaluations. The purpose is to evaluate athletic abilities and skill aptitude with fundamental baseball skills in the 4 main baseball categories of hitting, fielding, catching & throwing. This will provide baseline for our Coaches and Evaluation team to use when making decisions on team creations. Some additional skills such as pitching, catching, time/speed trials, arm strength or throwing velocity may be evaluated and used as additional info, but does not fall into the baseline categories that are required for the tryout format.

All players that have indicated their intention to try out for the AA teams will be assigned a group for Sessions 1 & 2. If applicable after these 2 sessions, groups will then be split into Royal (top team) and Red (2nd team) for the 3rd and final session of the AA tryouts. A list of these Royal & Red groups will be posted on our website for athletes to know which of the 3rd sessions they will be attending. Selected Coaches will also be announced for the team(s) prior to the final sessions to ensure they are involved in the final stage of the tryout process. Releases will be made after the 3rd session and the teams will be posted to our website along with further information regarding practice information.

Due to registration numbers this year we will only be having ONE 13U AA team, any cuts after the 2nd session will be placed into their respective community divisions.

Any players released from the AA teams, will be placed on their divisional community level teams or will be required to return to their home association. These players will not be required to attend the community evaluations.
